Any Disney "Princess" Movie: Little Mermaid, Cinderella, Snow White; they all end up getting hitched!

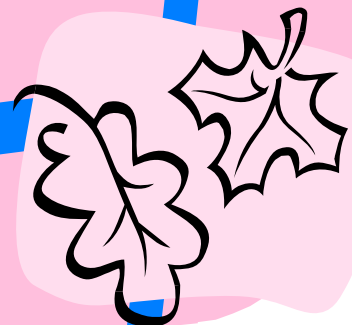
My Big Fat Greek Wedding: A lot of info about planning a wedding, family ties and how to deal with two different religious backgrounds. Funny!

Father of the Bride: Awe! Who doesn't love Steve Martin as a dad!?

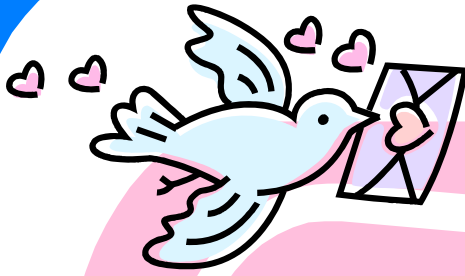
Oklahoma!: About a wedding? Who knew! Rent if you are in the mood for an old western musical.

Wedding lore and legend! Something old, something new...

The saying '*something old, something new, something borrowed, something blue*' dates back to Victorian time. *Something Old* represents the link with the bride's family and the past. A common solution many brides choose is to wear a piece of family jewelry. *Something New* represents good fortune and success in the bride's new life. The wedding dress is often chosen as the new item. *Something Borrowed* is to remind the bride that friends and family will be there for her when help is needed. The borrowed object might be something such as a lace handkerchief or an item of jewelry. *Something Blue* symbolizes of faithfulness and loyalty (blue represents purity). Frequently the brides garter is the blue item.
